Minimum Documents Required for Application (Poland):

- 1. Valid Passport (minimum 1-year validity)
- 2. Passport Size Photographs (white background)
- 3. Updated Resume / CV
- 4. Educational Certificates (high school or higher)
- 5. Skill Certificates (if applying for Skilled/Semi-Skilled jobs)
- 6. Experience Letters (if applicable)
- 7. Medical Certificate (from authorized medical center)
- 8. Police Clearance Certificate
- 9. COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate
- 10. Signed Employment Contract (if already issued)
- 11. Visa Application Form (Filled)
- 12. Proof of Address (recent utility bill or rental agreement)
- 13. Any other document requested by employer or embassy

Latest Policies & Rules Introduced by the Government of Poland (as of 2025):

- 1. Simplified Work Permit Process: Foreign workers applying for seasonal, skilled, or hospitality jobs can now access a faster work permit process under the new labor demand scheme launched in early 2025.
- 2. Minimum Wage Regulations: The national minimum wage in Poland has been updated to 4,300 PLN gross/month for full-time positions effective from January 1, 2025.
- 3. Mandatory Health Insurance: All foreign workers must have valid Polish health insurance coverage before entry. Employers may sponsor this, but personal coverage is mandatory for part-time and seasonal workers.
- 4. Language Support Initiative: Government-certified language support and onboarding courses are now available for workers from non-EU countries.
